Here, two sentences express the same meaning. —

In sentence 1, the form of verb shows that the person denoted by the subject does something

i.e. Active Voice (i.e. subject does sthg).
acts

In sentence 2, the form of the verb shows that something is done to the person denoted by subject.

i.e. something is done to Raja.

i.e. Passive Voice (i.e. something is done to subject or when object does something for suffers or receives some action)

Note:- Only transitive verbs can be used in the passive voice, because an intransitive verb has no object.
