

Small Practice Question for interviews: —

Q Can we start a thread more than once in a block?

No, because whenever we call `start()` method more than once in a block of code, java throws `IllegalThreadStateException`.

You can try the following example, compile & run it.

class A extends Thread

{
 public void run()

{
 System.out.println("Thread A started");
 }

public static void main(String a[])

{
 A a = new A();

a.start();

a.start();
}

}

→ and check the error on compilation.
