

After New Project Dialog Box appears, we have several options, where we can start writing a new program or load an existing program so we can modify it.

Starting a New Program - After we have the New Project Dialog Box displayed, we have a number of templates of the different types of programs we want to create -

⇒ Standard EXE - It creates a stand-alone program that we can copy, give away, or sell to others.

Examples of stand-alone programs are Microsoft Word, Netscape Navigator etc. Stand alone programs have an .EXE file extension.

⇒ ActiveX DLL - It creates a file that has a .DLL file extension. ActiveX DLL files are not meant to be used by them. Instead, these types of files contain subprograms designed to be used as building blocks when creating a stand-alone program.

⇒ ActiveX EXE - It creates a file that
