⇒ IIS Application — An IIS (Internet Information Server) application is a Visual Basic application that lives on a web server and responds to requests from the browser. An IIS application uses HTML to present its user interface and uses compiled Visual Basic code to process requests and responds to events in the browser. IIS applications can be used on the Internet or an Intranet. End users of an IIS application do not need a specific operating system or browser. IIS applications use the Active Server Pages (ASP) object model.
