

- (a) Pointer — The pointer provides a way to move and resize forms and controls. This is not a control.
- (b) Picture Box — The picture box control displays bitmaps, icons or windows metafiles. It displays text or acts as a visual container for other controls.
- (c) Label — The label control displays text. A user cannot interact with or modify. It displays only non-editable text. The text of a Label control can be modified at the form design time or by coding at the run time of VB program.
- (d) TextBox — The textbox control provides an area to enter or display text. There are two types of Text box — (i) Single line text box ~~and~~ and (ii) MultiLine text box. The maximum length of text of a textbox in VB is 65535.
- (e) Frame — The frame control provides a visual and functional
