

→ Hyper Media :-

Hyper Media Systems includes the non-linear information links of hypertext systems and the continuous and discrete media of multimedia systems.

For ex. → if a non-linear link consisted of text and video data, then this is a hyper media, multimedia and hypertext system.

Hypermedia is a superset of hypertext. Hypermedia documents contain links not only to other pieces of text, but also to other forms of media - sound, images and movies. Images themselves can be selected to link to sounds or documents. This means that browsers might not display a text file, but might display images or sound or animation. Hypermedia simply combines hypertext and multimedia. Hypermedia is a term created by Ted Nelson. Hypermedia is used as a logical extension of the term hypertext in which graphics, audio, video, plain text and hyperlinks to create a generally non-linear medium of information. The world wide web is a classic example of hypermedia.
