The Contribution of European Literature:

However as a result of colonisation, many indigenous literary traditions were destroyed. Authors like Doris Lessing, Chinua Achebe, and Jean Rhys are examples of post-colonial authors who have written writing that challenges the impacts of European colonisation on language culture and literature in formerly colonised nations. Achebe is particularly well-known for degrading the work usage of the English language.
